| Week 1 | We have learnt numbers to 21. Can you remember them? Watch the BBC Bitesize <br> - KS1 - French - numbers class clip video of the French children playing hopscotch. <br> Have a go at completing the 'Combien de chiens' (How many dogs) worksheet and <br> the numbers to 20 crossword. |
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| Week 2 | As we are not in school in England I thought we could go to see what school is like <br> in France! Have a look on BBC Bitesize - KS2 - French - class clips - At school. <br> There are 3 videos. Today watch the first video 'Not Again Farley - School <br> (French)'. What words can you recognise? You will hear some of the numbers you <br> know when Farley talks about the time. Can you work out what some of the <br> subjects are called? Soda's translating hat will help you! <br> If you like you can also watch the video 'A Primary School in Marseille' to watch <br> what a day is like in a French school. |
| Week 3 | Today we'll look at the daily routine of some children at school in France. Watch <br> the BBC Bitesize clip 'Daily school routines in French' where Papo, the parrot, visits <br> a French school. Can you write a list of words that Papo learns? You will already <br> know some of them eg Je m'appelle = My name is. There will be some new words <br> too eg en range = line up. |

## Summer 2

| Week 1 | Today we're going to listen to a story in French. It's the story of The Little Red Hen <br> - La Petite Poule Rousse. If you don't know the story in English then it might be a <br> good idea to read it as knowing the story will help you understand the French. You <br> will find the story at School 360. Log in to your school 360. Go to Resources - <br> Modern Languages - The Little Red Hen. You can listen to it in French and Spanish <br> so you'll need to click on La Petite Poule Rousse as we want to listen to it in <br> French! Press on 'Joue' to play the story, 'Pause' to pause it and 'Debut' will take <br> you back to the beginning of the story. <br> Once you have listened to the story use the story script from your pack to see if <br> you can find out what the animals in the story are called. Write the English above <br> the French words. |
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| Week 2 | Listen to the story of La Petite Poule Rousse again today. Can you order the story <br> cards (in your pack) correctly? What other words from the story can you hear and <br> read on the story cards? Remember, listen to the words carefully and don't sound <br> them out as they are often pronounced differently to the way they are written. |
| Week 3 | Listen to the story of La Petite Poule Rousse again. Can you practise retelling the <br> story using some of the French words? Once you have practised you could ask <br> someone to video you retelling the story and send it to me. I'd love to hear it. |
